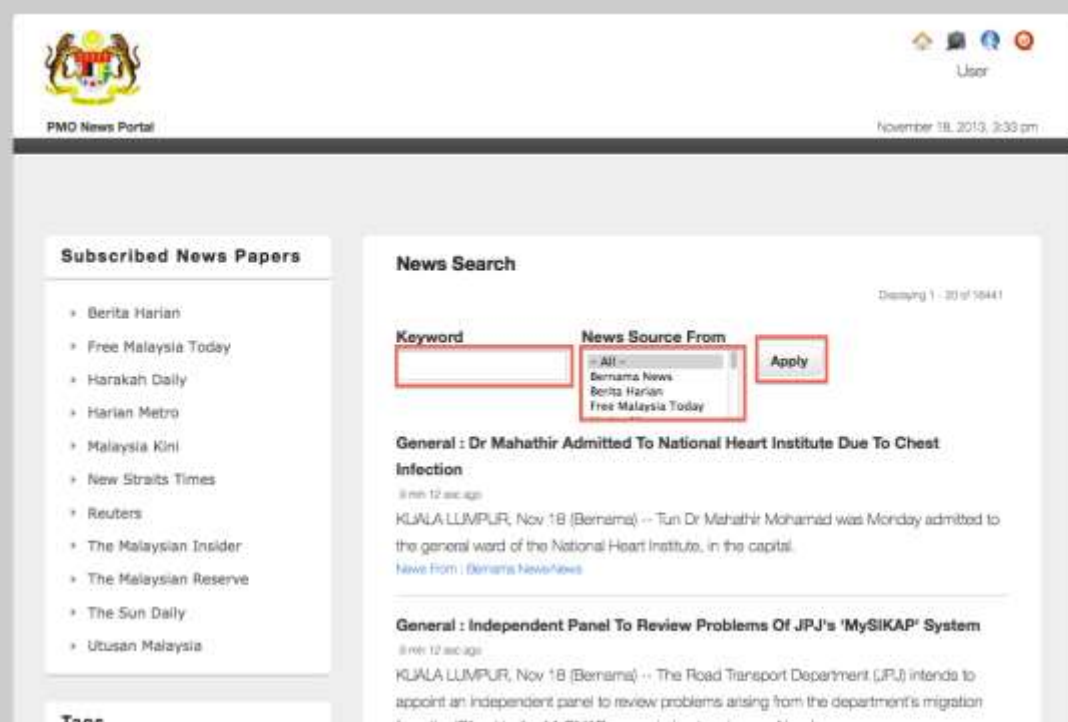



Our house crumpled to the ground soon after," the 38-year-old added. The couple were joined by two other families and spent more than six hours in the dark, damp cavern as rising storm surge waters edged dangerously closer and closer to its entrance, frightened that they would drown or be swept out to sea. "We could hear the typhoon outside. It sounded like a bulldozer," Isquardo said. "We were afraid of the sea."


